TRAINING APPROVAL CONDITIONS

Fire protection district firefighters training on structures outside any urban growth area or any city, for the instruction in methods of fire fighting may conduct training without a permit (RCW 70.94.6528), but must meet the following conditions. Please complete the following checklist and submit the appropriate supporting documentation:

- In consideration of prevailing air patterns, the fire is unlikely to cause air pollution in areas of sensitivity downwind of the proposed fire location;
- The fire is not located in an area that is declared to be in an air pollution episode or any stage of impaired air quality as defined in RCW 70.94.715 and 70.94.473;
- Nuisance laws are applicable to the fire, including nuisances related to the unreasonable interference with the enjoyment of life and property and the depositing of particulate matter or ash on other property;
- Notice of the training exercise fire has been provided to adjoining property owners, to other persons who may potentially be impacted by the fire, & to additional persons in a broader manner if specifically requested by NWCAA;
- Each structure proposed to be set on fire must be identified specifically as a structure to be set on fire. Each other structure on the same parcel not to be set on fire, must be identified as such;
- Asbestos inspection conducted (*please provide written documentation*);
- Asbestos notification and removal completed, if detected (*please submit a copy of the notification*);
- Mercury containing thermostats and switches identified, properly removed and disposed of in a safe manner (contact your local County Solid Waste Department for more information; Whatcom County 360.380.4640; Skagit County - 360.424.9532; Island County - 360.679.7386)
