# SEPA DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:** Revise Order of Approval to Construct #890b to acknowledge that the Sulfur Recovery Unit can operate up to its maximum elemental production capacity of 270 long tons per day. This air quality permit revision will not increase any emission limits established in the existing permit.

**PROPONENT:** BP West Coast Products LLC, Cherry Point Refinery
